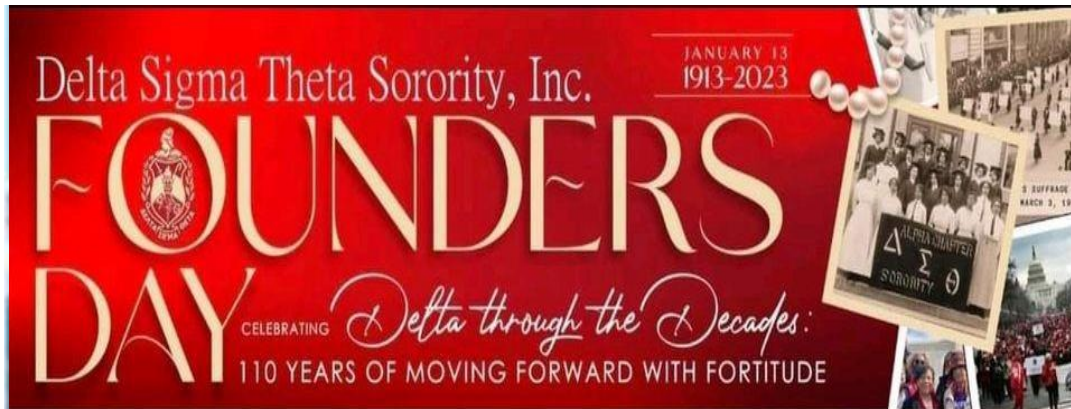

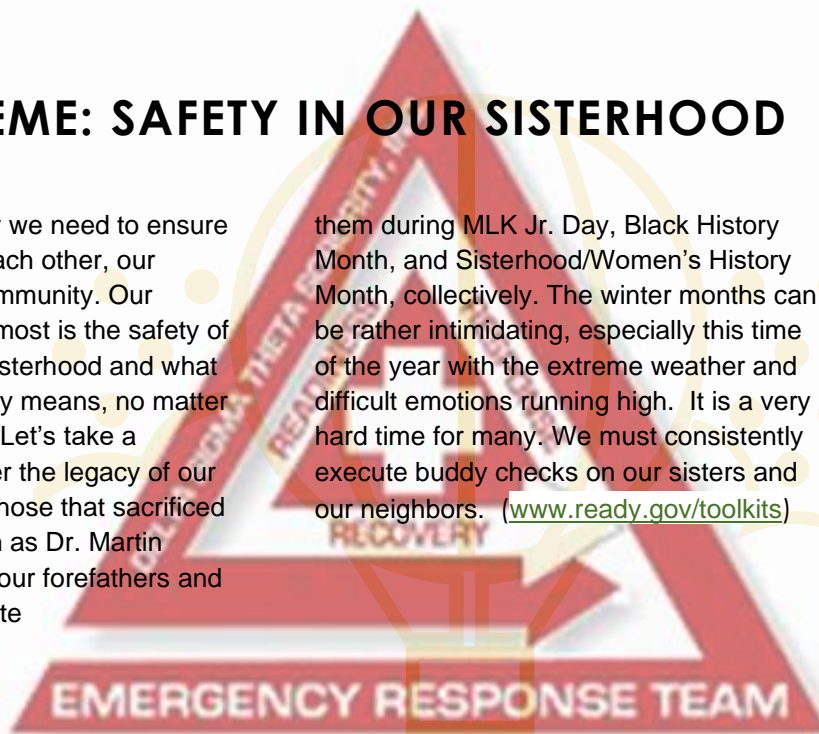

JANUARY COLD WEATHER TIPS

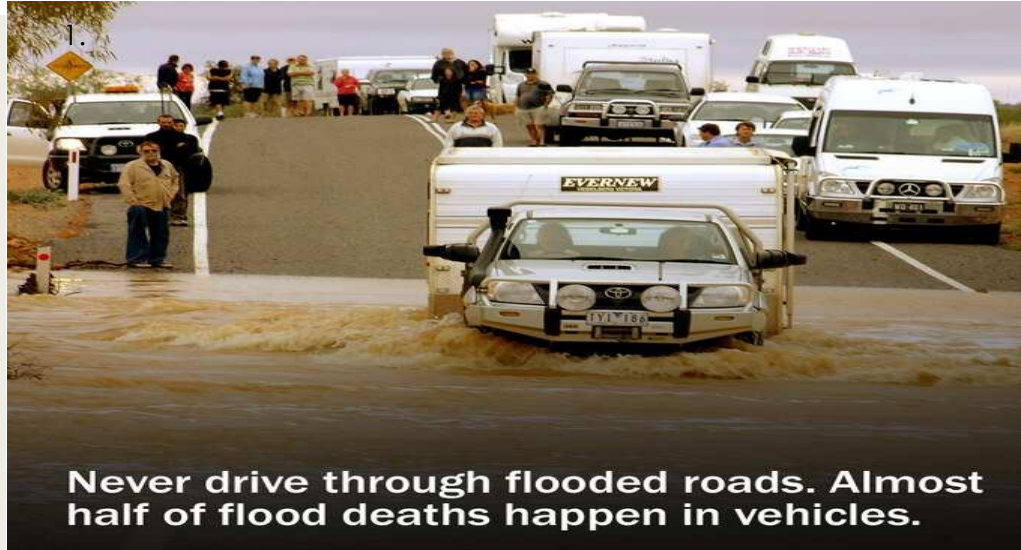

MARCH Spring and Flood Safety

1. Make a family emergency communication plan and include pets.
2. Have emergency supplies in place at home, at work, and in the car.
3. Listen to local officials by radio, TV, or social media.
4. Never drive or walk-through flooded streets; **Turn Around, Don't Drown!** Do not go through flood waters.
5. Evacuate when advised by authorities.



Never drive through flooded roads. Almost half of flood deaths happen in vehicles.

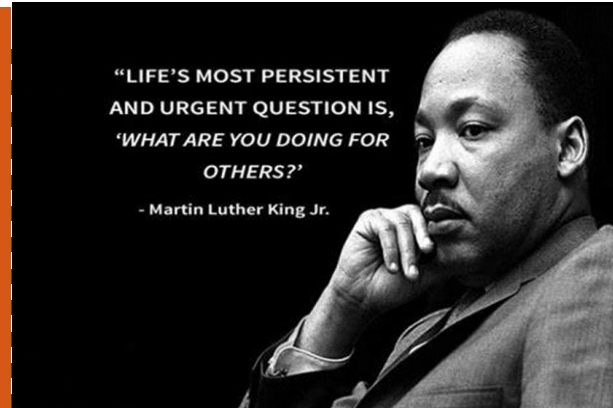
