This year, the Fort Knox Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. will be awarding a total of five (5) scholarships:

- 1). The Blondell E. Williams Annual Scholarship in the amount of \$1000. This scholarship is awarded annually to an **African American female Senior** who has demonstrated excellence academically and in the community during their high school career.
- 2). The Historically Black College or University (HBCU) Scholarship in the amount of \$500. This scholarship is awarded annually to **ANY student** who has demonstrated excellence academically, in the community, and will be attending a HBCU.
- 3). The Heart of Service Community scholarship in the amount of \$500. This scholarship will be awarded to **ANY student** who have demonstrated a heart of service in their community during their high school career.
